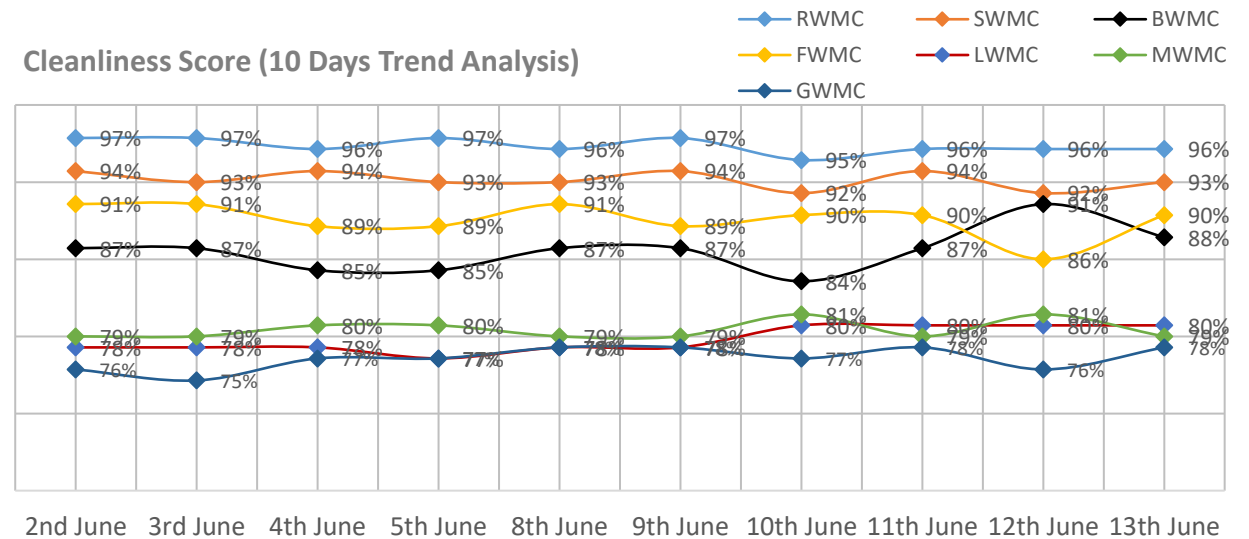
### Complaints Compliance (95%)

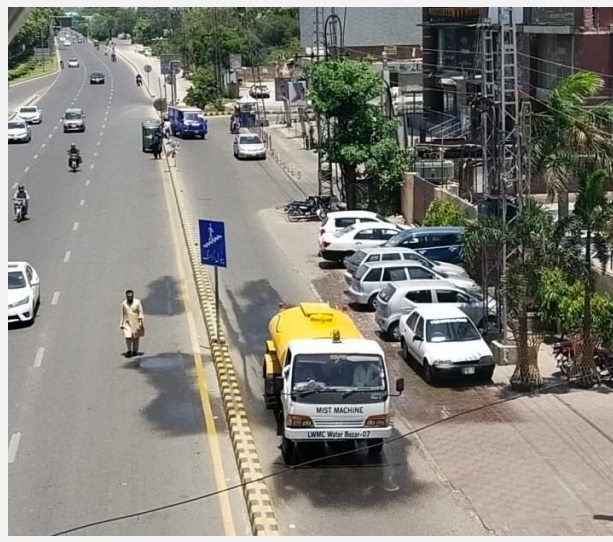
